

## **Bush Intercontinental Airport to Paul Comstock Partners**

- Upon leaving Bush Airport follow the directional signs to I-45 South (Gulf Freeway) and Beltway 8 (Sam Houston Tollroad).
- Take Beltway 8 West to exit to I-45 South toward downtown.
- Follow I-45 South to I-610 West.
- Take exit 51 to merge on to I-610 West.
- Take the exit to I-610 South and move to the center lanes. (do not take I-10 West)
- Take the first freeway exit 10A - Woodway Dr./Memorial Dr. - to your right.
- Keep to the right and turn right at the first traffic light - Woodway Dr. and gradually move to the left lane.
- At the second light (S Post Oak Lane) turn left and stay in the left lane.
- We are in the building on your left to which there are two driveways.
- Take the second (Riverway) which separates the two buildings and curves to your left.
- Continue along Riverway past our building and to your left you will find the entrance to our parking garage.

### **Entering the Parking Garage**

- Go down the ramp of the parking garage and as you enter you will see the Visitor Parking slots designated with a blue sign on the wall.
- The Visitor Parking can be found directly to your right or straight ahead as you first enter the garage.
- Should you find the spaces occupied you may park in a space without any signage.
- However, you may also take advantage of the Reserved Spaces Paul Comstock Partners has on the second level.
- As you enter the Parking Garage continue straight ahead up the ramp.
- Make a right turn and follow the ramp up to another right turn – continue up and after one more right turn you will find our spaces to your right designated with a white Reserved Parking sign.
- The spaces begin at the top of the current ramp and continue down 5 spaces. Please use any one of these.

### **Elevator from 2<sup>nd</sup> level to Ground**

- Once you are out of your car – follow the ramp up and you will see the elevators to your right.
- Take the Elevator to the “G” ground level and follow the walkway to the front door.
